



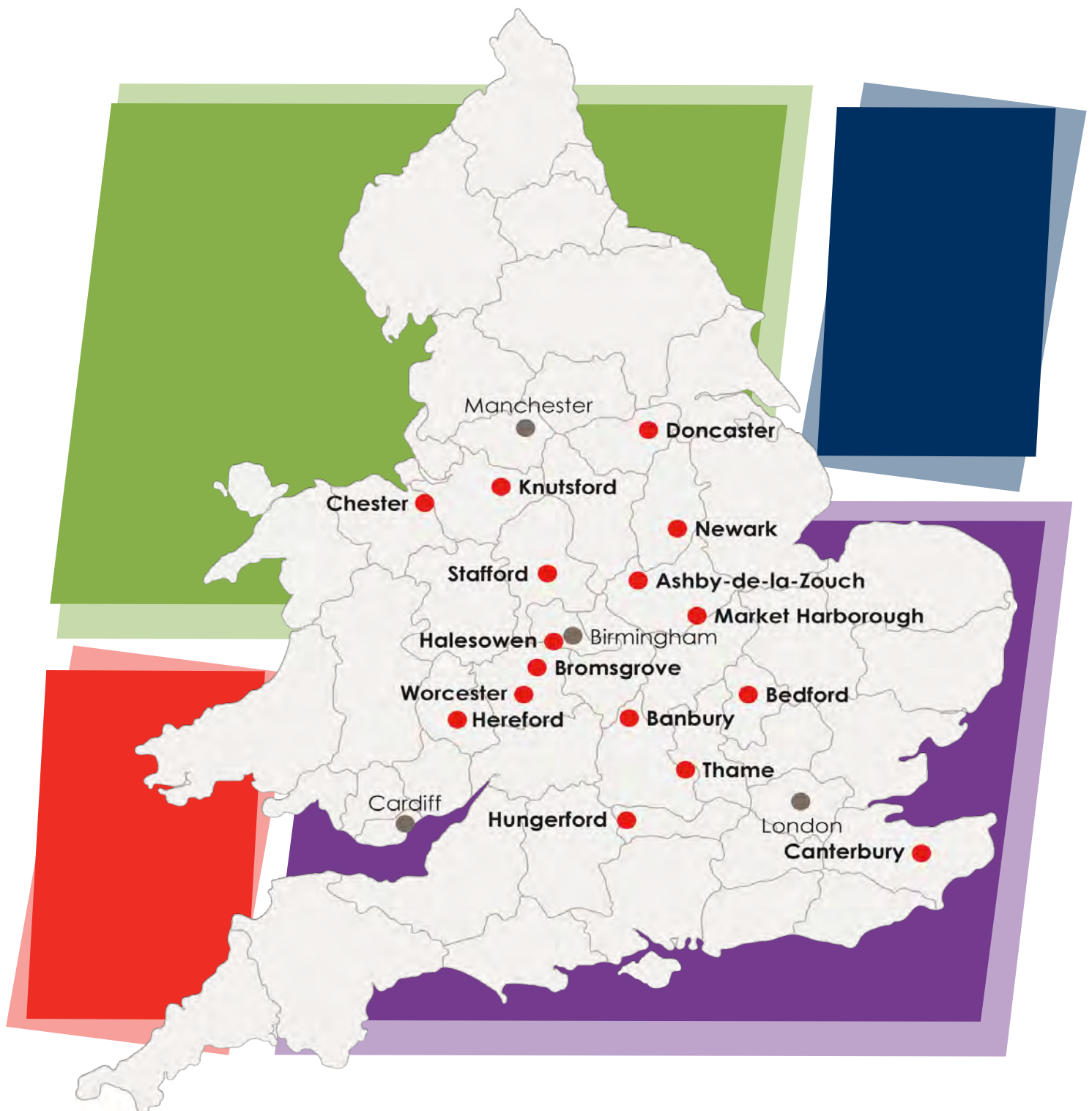

I was encouraged to take on responsibility for tasks where possible, and the gaps in my theoretical knowledge were soon filled with practical experience of surveying.
